ANTIOCH PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, CASHVILLE, S.C. Founded 1843. Succeeded by Antioch (Reidville) Presbyterian Church 1884. Cashville church reorganized 1904 as Old Antioch. Presbytery: South Carolina 1843-1878, Enoree 1878-1883, 1904-1973, Calvary 1973-present. County: Spartanburg (District 1843-1868, County 1868-present). Variant names: Old Antioch (esp. 1904 until 1914, when the church at Reidville took the name of Reidville Presbyterian Church), Antioch Meeting House, Variant location references: Fair Forest Creek (which flows into the Tyger River and then into the Broad River), Reidville 1883; address of Antioch sometimes given as Simpsonville, Wellford, or Switzer after 1904. History: Howe (II: 748); Jones and Mills (693-695); historical notes, undated and unsigned (Eula Anderson?, 1920s?) (at Montreat); annual history updates (1935-1972) (at Montreat).
