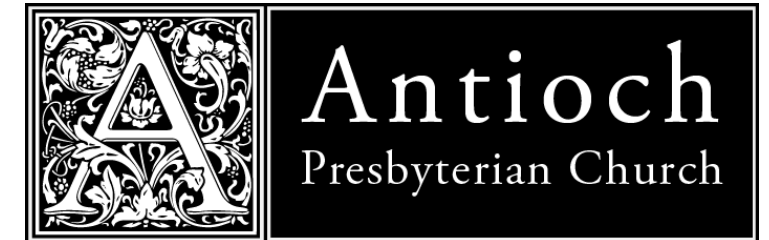
Leadership & Accountability
