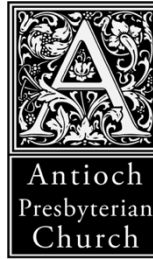

Worship at Antioch

The worship of the one true and living God is mankind's highest duty and greatest delight. Therefore, we involve children as participants in worship. The children of believing parents are to be students of the Christian Faith – even baptized disciples – from infancy, and thus are not to be excluded from the assembling together of the saints. 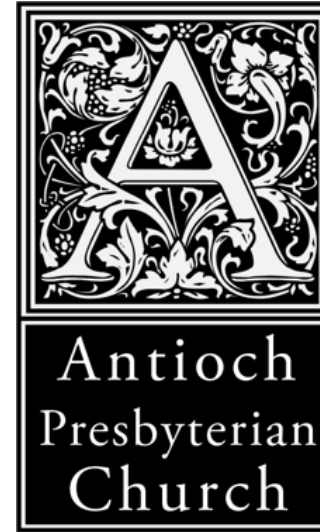
