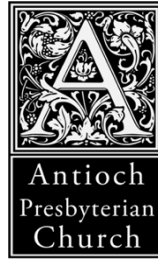

Worship at Antioch

Therefore, we involve children as participants in worship. 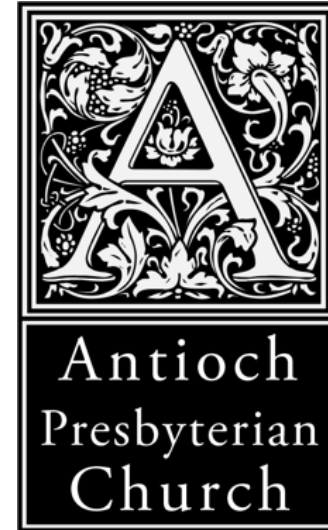
